## Young Families Connect (YFC)

The Focus of YFC is to assist expectant and/or parenting women and men ages 13-24 years of age, to overcome life's challenges and achieve their goals by:

- Increasing self sufficiency
- Improving health and wellness
- Improving parenting skills

All young women and men who enroll in the YFC program are expected to participate in all components of the program for a minimum of 1 year and a maximum of 2 years. In order to receive support and financial assistance offered by the program, individuals are required to participate in Incredible Years parenting classes, Ready, Set, Plan workshops and Domestic Violence Prevention classes.



### Services Provided:

- Case Management - developing and maintaining individual goal plans.
- Financial assistance with childcare, transportation, and medical services for Parent or child.
- Assistance with Education such as GED completion or Continuing education
- Assistance with seeking employment.



### Participant Expectations:

In order to receive support and financial assistance offered by the program, participants must participate in the following:

- Incredible Years parenting classes for parents of children ages 3-6.
- Ready, Set, Plan Workshops (Health and Wellness Training)
- Domestic Violence Prevention workshops
- Employment skills building workshops
